SUBJECT: Agenda item request

The LDOE requires that the Iberia Parish Early Childhood Community Network provide the opportunity for public comment regarding the number of requested seats for the 2018 - 2019 school year. According to Section 709 of Bulletin 140, each Lead Agency must submit a Coordinated Funding Request on behalf of their Community Network to the Louisiana Department of Education.

The purpose of the Coordinated Funding Request is to acquire seats for LA4, NSECD, and the PreK Expansion Grant for 2018-2019. These programs serve at-risk children only and have income eligibility requirements for children and families. Each program partner reviewed the October 1 child count data to evaluate their capacity levels and waiting list numbers to determine the request for seats. (See attached document.)

The Iberia Parish Early Childhood Community Network requests that the following item be placed on the November 15th school board agenda as a Report Only item:

The Iberia Parish Early Childhood Community Network requests to the Louisiana Department of Education that 320 seats be provided in the LA4 Pre-K Program and that no seats be provided for the NSECD or PreK Expansion Grant for the 2018-2019 school year.
